How do I trade the share?

How can European citizens trade shares?

At this point Spotlight does not have any equivalent member as to Avanza and Nordnet with European presence and information in English. However, at Nordnet's Swedish site you can open an account following the steps below:

- Fill out the account agreement <https://www.nordnet.se/pdf/se/aktiedepa.pdf> (Please call Nordnet for translation assistance at +46 8 506 330 00)
- Subsidy that reinforce your foreign address (eg purchase contract on accommodation, statement from foreign bank or excerpt from government registers such as tax authorities, insurance funds etc. which shows the address)
- Basis that reinforces the origin of deposited funds at the depot (depending on how the KYC form is filled with regards to where the money and / or securities which are transferred to Nordnet come from) for example, salary specification, etc.
- Copy of valid passport

Documents can be sent to info@nordnet.se for a review but we need all documents sent in original form to approve the application.
